

# Marching Mizzou Alumni Band Annual Business Meeting,

1 p.m., Oct. 22, 2016, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, Hearnes Building

- I. **Welcome** – Board President Johanna Reed Adams
- II. **Minutes of business meeting**, Oct. 10, 2015 – Board secretary Elysia Gooding (vote needed to accept) Copies of the minutes were not at the meeting, so no vote was taken on them; April Sansing did a brief recap of last year's meeting from memory.
- III. **M2AB bylaws annual approval** (vote needed) Copies of the bylaws as revised in 2015 were passed out; the membership approved them with no changes this year.
- IV. **Report on M2AB finances** – April Sansing, board treasurer (no vote needed) April provided copies of M2AB's income and expenses for 2016 up to this point; the report included record of income and expenses for the previous five years. She noted that we typically spend more than we take in, including the allocation that we get from the Mizzou Alumni Association. There was a question (an explanation) about what the expense is for the Concert on the Quad picnic that we provide each year for Marching Mizzou at the end of its Band Camp week on the Sunday evening before Fall Semester classes begin.
- V. Announcement of **M2AB Hall of Fame 2016 honor: Sharon Schiller Fusco**  
Sharon expressed her thanks for the recognition and talked about her long tenure with M2AB. (Honorees: 2010 - Dr. Alex Pickard, Eric Kegley, Kevin Kelly; 2011 - Stuart Woody; 2012 - Bruce Anderson, Mark Thurlo; 2013 - Dr. Brad Snow, Gary Taylor; 2014 - Terry (Palmer) Fetterly, Becky (Shepard) Latko, Bill Moyes, Lesley (Pauley) Mueller; 2015 - Hadley Haux)
- VI. **Congratulations to board member Enola Riann White** (not present at this meeting), winner of a Mizzou Alumni Association G.O.L.D. (Graduate of the Last Decade) Award, nominated by M2AB Board.
- VII. **Marching Mizzou scholarships** will be announced in December at Marching Mizzou end-of-semester banquet – Heather Henderson talked about the reason for the change to doing scholarship applications and interviews after Homecoming instead of beforehand (it works better for the M2 and M2AB officers' schedules)
- VIII. Reminder, **M2AB's membership code** with MAA is UMZ (MAA pays for about one-fourth of M2AB's annual expenses, based on M2AB members who belong to MAA.)
- IX. Dr. Erin Cooper, Marching Mizzou director and ex-officio M2AB board member, talked about this year's band and her whirlwind schedule since being hired last summer. She gave her appreciation of M2AB's participation this weekend, and the hard work that marchers did to get ready for the pre-game show.
- X. **Review of this weekend's activities (comments, discussion, feedback)** There was discussion about the bus service to and from the game and whether it's worth it to spend \$800 when only 18 people used the service. Some people said they didn't

know the bus was available, and asked that it be better publicized. Some people said they didn't get postcards or other communications about Reunion weekend.

**X. Elections for Board of Directors (11 seats open)**

*(Nominations, including self-nominations, are welcome for all seats)*

Four of 11 board members chose not to run for re-election: Sharon Schiller Fusco (1980s), Heather Henderson ('81-'83), Andy Kendig ('79-'83), Enola Riann White ('04-'07).

Four 3-year terms (2017-2019) [vote required]

*Nominees:* These were self-nominated before the meeting: Johanna Reed Adams (incumbent, president, '77-'80), Elysia Gooding (incumbent, secretary, 2010s), Kevin Jerez (incumbent, 2010s), April Sansing (incumbent, treasurer, '02-'06). Kelsey Kelley (graduate in 2016) was nominated. These four were elected to 3-year terms: Gooding, Jerez, Sansing, Kelley

Four 2-year terms (2017-2018) [vote required]

*Nominees:* These were self-nominated before the meeting: Bobby Geerlings (incumbent, '83-'87), Lew Keathley (incumbent, vice president, '80-'83), Bill Moyes ('71-'75). Keathley was not allowed to run, per our bylaws, because he was not present. Joseph Trammell and Johanna Reed Adams were nominated. By acclamation, these four win 2-year terms: Geerlings, Moyes, Trammell, Adams.

Three 1-year terms (2017) [vote required]

*Nominees:* Gene Hartley (incumbent, '73-'78) was self-nominated before the meeting. Taylor Ericson ('01-'04), Tom Froidl and Mollie Froidl ('93-96) [check spelling of these names] were nominated. Hartley withdrew from the race. By acclamation, these three win 1-year terms: Ericson, Froidl, Froidl

Note: Starting in 2017, all seats will be elected for three-year terms (3 seats in 2017, 4 seats in 2018, 4 seats in 2019, 3 seats in 2020, 4 seats in 2021, 4 seats in 2022, etc.).
